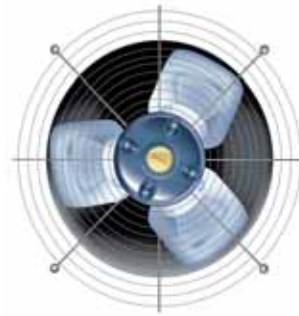


Do you have a bike permit?

In order to better track bikes in the building, a bike permit will be issued for each bike kept in the building, whether it is stored in your apartment, storage locker, or bike room. If a bike is kept in an unlocked area or common area of the building, it could be considered abandoned and removed from the building. Please contact the office to obtain a permit.

Air Conditioner Removal

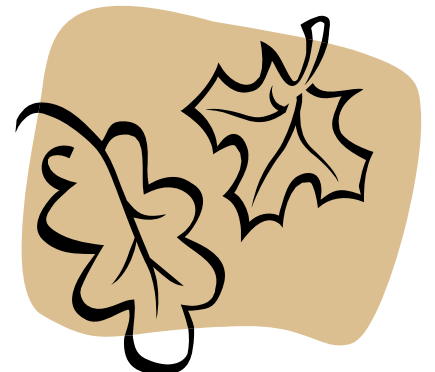

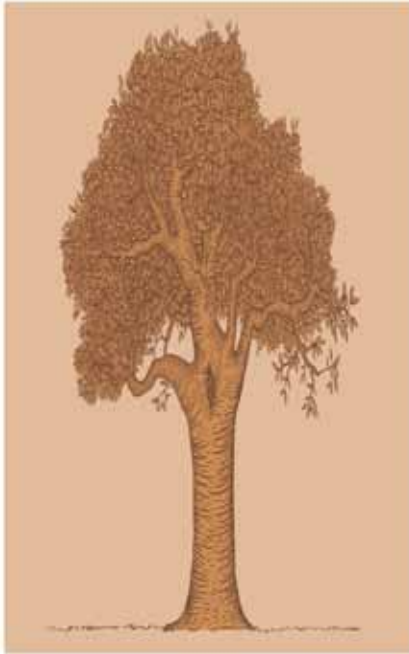
