

Xmas Tree Care

Residents often ask if live holiday trees are allowed. We do allow them, but we ask residents to use care and follow these guidelines:

- 1.We recommend using a tarp or tree bag while moving your tree in or out of the building. Please vacuum up any needles your tree sheds in the hallways and common areas.
- 2. You are responsible for keeping your tree watered. A dry tree can be a very dangerous fire hazard.
- Make sure to use some kind of floor covering, like plastic and a towel, underneath your tree to prevent water damage to the floor.
- 4. If your tree has lights, please do not leave them on when you are not home.
- 5. Trees <u>cannot</u> go into the trash behind the buildings.
