Eliminate Junk Mail for Earth Day!

While we are more than happy to provide recycling right next to our mailboxes, we would like to cut down on all of the junk mail received at Skally Management buildings. To help our residents eliminate junk mail, we are providing simple instructions below on how to get yourself off of mailing lists. Plus, with this newsletter, we are providing form letters for getting off the list for some of the mass mailers we all receive every week. **You can return these letters to us and we will mail them for you!**

Instructions to get off the mailing list for Val-Pak coupons

1 - You can mail a request.

This gets you off the list for 2-years. Mail in an empty Val-Pak blue envelope with your address on it.

2 - You can call in a request.

If you call 1-888-797-1896 and select the option to get off the "Sweepstakes" mailing list, this will get you off the Val-Pak list permanently. Follow the prompts to give them 1) your street address, 2) your city, 3) your state, 4) your zip code.

3 - Go online to get off the list.

Go to <http://www.coxtarget.com/mailexpression/s/DisplayMailSuppressionForm> and fill out the online form.

* Remember, all of the Val-Pak coupons are available online, so you can still access them if you're off the list.



How to get off mailing lists affiliated with the Direct Marketing Association
