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Important Fall & Early Winter Reminders

Winter is on the way and the heating system is turned on, so please:



- ◆ Remove your window air conditioners as soon as possible.
- ◆ Keep your outer storm windows closed at all times.
- ◆ Keep your inner windows closed at all times.
- ◆ As the weather gets colder, car, house and apartment break-ins increase. Be sure to keep valuables in your cars and apartments out of site. Also, be sure to use the locks on your car doors, apartment doors and windows.

- ◆ Please remember to clean food and debris off dishes before washing them. Our sinks do not have food disposals and our drain pipes are more prone to getting clogged.

If your apartment temperature is too warm or too cold (below 65 degrees), let us know and we will make adjustments. Questions or concerns? Please call us!

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Apartment Inspections This Monday and Tuesday!!!

This Monday and Tuesday (October 15th and 16th) from 8:30am to 4:30pm we will be inspecting all the apartments in your building to check:

1. that A/C's have been removed (if they have not been we will take them out of the window and set them on the floor),
2. all windows are properly closed,
3. and smoke detectors are functioning (remember that you should check your smoke detector at least once a month to make sure it works).

Please call or email the office if there is a time that does not work for us to enter your apartment.

Electronic Rent Payments = No Late Fees

Rent is due on or before the 1st of each month. While late fees aren't charged unless we receive your rent after the 3rd of the month, paying your rent late is a violation of your lease. Plus, you could be given notice to move if rent is paid late on a regular basis.

Maintenance Issues: Large, Small and Emergencies ...Call Us!

If you have any maintenance issues call or email us so we can address them promptly.

If there is an emergency call the on-site person listed in the front entry of your building and 911. The on-site person can often assist the police and/or fire department in getting access into apartments or other areas of the building.
