DRINK GREEN: FORGET PLASTIC & USE A WATER BOTTLE!!

It may not seem like a big deal to rely on bottled water for convenience sake, but using bottled water has a BIG price for all of us—environmentally and economically.

DID YOU KNOW.... ? In the U.S., we consumed 17% of the world’s bottled water in 2004. To make all of the plastic to hold all of the bottled water we consume requires MORE than 1.5 million barrels of oil each year! That’s enough oil to run 100,000 cars for a year! Plus, many plastic bottles do not get recycled and fill up our landfills.

Most tap water is safe to drink, but if you don’t like tap water, try using a filtered water pitcher that you can keep in your frig. If you’re on the go, you can get plastic water bottles in a variety of sizes and styles to take with you from home.

Keep in mind, some studies have found out that probably at least 40% of bottled water is tap water anyway! You may as well save money and natural resources by drinking water from home.

IMPORTANT SAFETY & SECURITY REMINDERS
