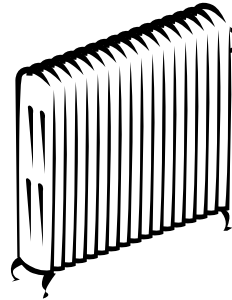
Winter is on the way!

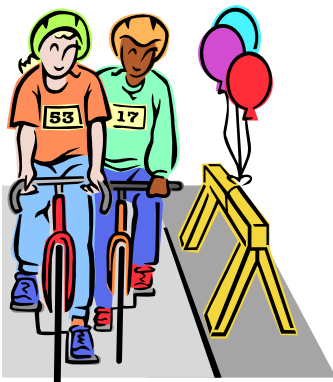

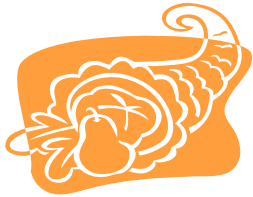


BIKE PERMIT REMINDERS
