At Skally Management, we see “living green” as an ongoing process that requires an open mind, creativity and the sharing of information.

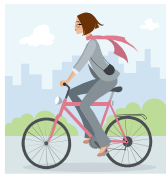

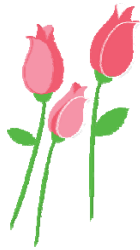
