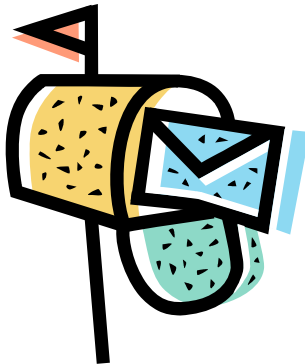

You should have received a census form from the federal government sometime in March. It's very important to fill out your census form and mail it back. Federal funding for roads, transportation, schools as well as the number of representatives Minnesota has in Congress is tied to our population count according to the US Census.

Keep in mind that the Census keeps all information confidential. Also, if you don't send in your form, the Census will send someone out to visit you. So, please remember to send back your form!
