We're all concerned with security and it takes all of us to help keep the building safe.

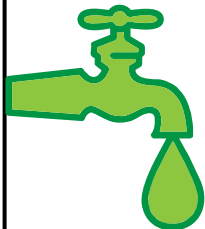
Please remember:

Help Conserve Water!

If you notice that you have broken or leaking faucets or a running toilet, please call our office to request a maintenance visit. These kinds of leaks waste a lot of water that really adds up! A leak that amounts to one drop per second can add up to 2,700 gallons of wasted water in one year! (source: Do It Green MN)



July Green Tip: What is Vermiculture?

It may sound unconventional, but vermiculture (composting kitchen waste with worms) is a safe, easy way to compost right in your apartment kitchen.
