## How to Light a Pilot Light

With a gas stove, there are usually 3 pilot lights that remain lit at all times. If a pilot light goes out, you might smell gas. If this happens, you can easily re-light your pilot light. Just hold a match over the pilot light area under the stove top (it's located between the two burners) or at the back of the broiler under your oven.

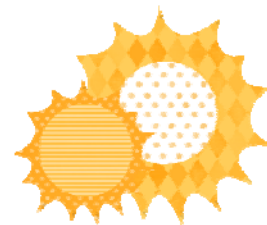
