## Fire Safety Reminder

### Common Fire Hazards

**Candles** – Never leave candles unattended for any period of time.

**Broiler Pan** – The drawer in the bottom of your oven is a cooking area. Do not store flammables: Oven mitts, towels, aprons, etc. Also do not store things that can melt or are sensitive to heat.

**Grease Fire** – Never attempt to put a grease fire out with water. Smother a fire that occurs on a stove top with a wet dish towel.

**Unplug Bathroom Items** – Including: Hair Driers, Flat/Curling Irons. These items are easy to leave on and forget about.

**Cigarettes** – even though most of our buildings are Smoke Free, cigarette butts are a common source of apartment fires.

**Outdoor Grilling** – Charcoal grills must be at LEAST 15 FEET away from a building. Please be sure to tend to any summer grilling that you are doing, and make sure the coals and ashes are completely out before leaving unattended.
