- ◆ KEEP YOUR INNER WINDOWS AND STORM WINDOWS CLOSED AT ALL TIMES. IF YOU ARE MISSING A STORM WINDOW FOR SOME REASON, PLEASE LET US KNOW.
- ◆ MANY OF OUR APARTMENTS HAVE STEAM RADIATORS THAT MAKE SOME NOISE WHEN THE BOILER IS ON, THIS IS NORMAL. HOWEVER, STEAM AND WATER SHOULD NOT COME OUT OF THE RADIATOR VENTS. PLEASE CALL THE OFFICE IF YOU NOTICE THIS OCCURRING.
- ◆ IF YOUR APARTMENT IS TOO WARM OR TOO COLD (BELOW 65 DEGREES), PLEASE LET US KNOW SO WE CAN MAKE ADJUSTMENTS.
- ◆ REMEMBER: AS THE WEATHER GETS COLDER, CAR AND APARTMENT BREAK-INS OFTEN INCREASE. BE SURE TO KEEP VALUABLES IN YOUR CAR AND APARTMENT OUT OF SIGHT. PLEASE BE SURE TO KEEP YOUR CARS, WINDOWS AND APARTMENT DOORS LOCKED AT ALL TIMES TOO.
